

In 2019 he will return to Tate Modern for a major survey of his career so far. Eliasson creates experiences that can be shared by young and old – the exhibition includes a selection of these captivating immersive installations.

Portfolio inspiration

EXPLORE THE CITY & DEVELOP CREATIVE IDEAS

London is awash with inspiration to add to every pupils' portfolio of work. Fine artists will find sanctuary in the many dozens of galleries on offer, covering a variety of specialisms. Designers can get to grips with textiles from the 1950s onwards at the Fashion & Textile Museum, or drool over designs spanning graphics to furniture at the Design Museum.

The city itself is alive with artistic opportunity. Why not consider visiting some of London's more eclectic markets, take in the colours, movement, sounds, smells and enjoy a spot of street photography. Portobello market makes an interesting choice with its quirky, colourful shopfronts. 'Wow' buildings span many architectural eras and include castles, cathedrals, theatres, temples, skyscrapers, Ferris wheels and palaces.

Your group could document the urban landscape and varied architecture from above at the Shard or London Eye. There are great sculptures dotted around the city too. Keep an eye out in public squares, courtyards, parks and outside stations. Feed the emotion of other art forms into portfolios with a trip to the West End. Appreciate the staging and costumes of The Lion King, or take a backstage tour at the National Theatre to see prop and costume making on site.

NST work with staff on the planning and organisation of the galleries and museum visits for our pupils. They listen to what is required and try to get the best value for the pupils. I have planned all my trips with them for the last 7 years.

Liverpool



LEONARDO DA VINCI, THE COMPELLING EXHIBITION

MUSÉE NATIONAL DU LOUVRE 24th October 2019 - 24th February 2020 Celebrating the 500th anniversary of the artist's death

Here's 2019's most awaited event! This exhibition will pay tribute to the Florentine genius.

The display will take place in the great Napoleon Hall and be the occasion to celebrate the 500th anniversary of his death in Amboise in 1519.

Painter, scientist, philosopher, inventor, engineer, Leonardo da Vinci embodies Renaissance on his own and his genius is still fascinating 500 years after he passed away.

Portfolio inspiration

EXPLORE THE CITY & DEVELOP CREATIVE IDEAS

Steeped in history and culture, Paris is a true city of art and offers a wealth of portfolio building opportunities. There is no shortage of inspiration for fine artists within the city's many galleries and museums. The architecture of the buildings themselves is stunning, with examples being housed in a converted railway station (Musée D'Orsay), beneath glass pyramids (Musée National du Louvre), and even in a high-tech building design (Centre Pompidou).

The small, crooked lanes of Le Marais (close to the Centre Pompidou) are filled with fashionable art galleries and museums, and makes an interesting detour. To see artists in action, the Montmartre district is a must. Take your sketchbooks on a stroll through the cobbled streets and look out over the city from the steps of the stunning Sacré-Cœur. This is a great area for street photography too.

Photographers can also take to the skies and snap the stunning cityscape. Groups highly recommend the view from Montparnasse 56 Panorama. Close by is the Montparnasse cemetery, the resting place of many of France's artistic elite and a fascinating stopping-point for art history buffs.



ORIOL MASPONS, RETROSPECTIVE

Museu Nacional d'Arte de Catalunya 5th July 2019 - 12th January 2020

The first major retrospective exhibition of the work of the Barcelona photographer Oriol Maspons will present more than 40 years of intense activity. Covering reportage, portraiture, fashion and advertising, contextualizing his production and providing support for the research in the recovery of documentary material - books, magazines, record covers, etc. - the exhibition will also show us the final destination of the artist's photographs.

Gaudi Exhibition Center

The Gaudí Exhibition Center represents the starting point on the way to discovering who Gaudí was, finding out why and how he defined and executed his work, and so be able to take real advantage of the experience of visiting his buildings in Barcelona. It's a one-of-a-kind exhibition, and included in the visit is a virtual reality experience in which you can meet with Gaudí himself.

Portfolio inspiration

EXPLORE THE CITY & DEVELOP CREATIVE IDEAS

Barcelona is as much about what can be seen outdoors as indoors where art and design is concerned.

A walk through Park Güell itself can open up conversations about Gaudí's work from an architectural, cultural and artistic perspective. This is a great opportunity to add to sketchbooks. The views from here are outstanding too and ideal for landscape photographers, with options for photographing interesting 3D forms as well as macro work focusing on the beauty and colours of the many mosaics.

Architecture plays a huge part in any visit here, with examples of buildings throughout the ages from modern, functional flats to classic Gothic architecture. Gaudí's hugely impressive Sagrada Família deserves a specific mention too.

Modern art fans, textile designers and 3D enthusiasts will be in their element in the city with museums dedicated to Picasso, Miró and Dalí. Flamenco shows provide cultural inspiration, and street artists and photographers will be thoroughly entertained with people-watching on Las Ramblas

The Barcelona Olympic stadium was the venue for the 1992 Olympic games. Today the stadium is open to visitors to explore and see where all the action happened.













MUSEU PICASSO

Picasso's experiments with Impressionism, Pointillism and Symbolism are shown here in his early works. View his personal style from the Blue to Pink Period (1901-17) plus a gradual move into experimental cubism and abstract forms.



FUNDACIÓN JOAN MIRÓ

A white-walled temple to the most Catalan of all artists, which houses Miró works, including tapestries containing textile, paint and collage. Also displayed are leading 20th century artists, perfect for the study of form, colour and texture.



PARK GÜELL

Take a visit to the famous park which was designed by Antonio Gaudí. Beautiful examples of his extraordinary work can be seen here. A fascinating visit for all groups and a must for anyone studying



SAGRADA FAMÍLIA

Based on Gaudí's plans of 1954, this unfinished masterpiece remains a popular tourist attraction and a world renowned emblem of the city. Pupils will be amazed by its sheer size and its architectural complexity.




