Rome and the Bay of Naples have become our most popular Italian destinations for classics groups studying Roman life. ## At a glance

# Trip highlights – Rome



## THE COLOSSEUM

Who can resist a visit to the Colosseum? The world's largest surviving structure of Roman antiquity with its grandeur, wonders of construction and the horrors of the amphitheatre. Add a guide to truly set the scene and leave pupils in awe.



## ROMAN FORUM & PALATINE HILL

The oldest and most important structures of the ancient city, including the temple of Saturn and the complex of the Vestal Virgins. See the ruins of the Imperial Palaces and the Hut of Romulus, as well as a great view of the Circus Maximus.



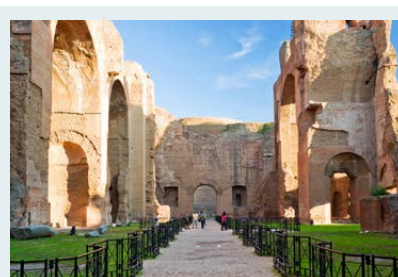
## PANTHEON

Built as a temple to all the gods and rebuilt circa 126AD during Hadrian's reign, it's still in use today. A marvel of Roman engineering and, until the middle of the 20th century, the largest masonry dome built.



## GUIDED VATICAN CITY TOUR

A visit through the Vatican Museums, accompanied by the local guide, will provide your group with the chance to see some of the world's finest examples of Greek sculpture and vase painting.



## GUIDED WALKING TOUR

Guided walks can be tailored to your requirements, here's a suggested 3-hour walk which includes the best of the **baths, temples** and **theatres** of Ancient Rome.

Visit the **Baths of Caracalla** and then on to **Circus Maximus** to see this ancient Roman chariot racing stadium. At the **Forum Boarium**, site of ancient Rome's meat market, your pupils will be able to view two small temples, the Temple of Hercules Victor and the Temple of Portunus, which are among the best preserved religious structures from Rome's republican era.

Make sure you tell the truth at the **Bocca della Verità** – the Mouth of Truth! This carved image of a man-like face, located in the portico of the church of Santa Maria, is famous for its role as a lie detector and, it was believed that if you told a lie when your hand was in the mouth of the sculpture then your hand would be bitten off! Walk up to the ancient, open-air **Theatre of Marcellus** where you will also find the **Portico d'Ottavia** and finish your tour with a visit to **Isola Tiberina** where you will see the **Ponte Fabricio**, a 1st century BC Roman Bridge.

#### • CAPITOLINE MUSEUM

An excellent collection of Roman statues, inscriptions and other artefacts.

#### • THE CATACOMBS

Ancient burial grounds of the early Christians. Local guide provided.

#### • OSTIA ANTICA

Explore the extensive remains of the Roman town.

#### • TIVOLI

Visit the fountains of the Villa d'Este gardens, and the Emperor Hadrian's villa.

#### • TIME ELEVATOR

Take a journey through the development of Rome and experience multi-sensorial effects as you watch panoramic screens.

#### • THE ARA PACIS

This monument is sculpted entirely in Luna marble and is an altar dedicated to Pax, the Roman Goddess of Peace.

#### • ROME BY NIGHT

See the sights of Rome by night on a guided tour.

#### • SPANISH STEPS

Situated in Piazza di Spagna, these 18th century majestic steps built in Baroque style are today a regular meeting place for Italians.

#### • TREVI FOUNTAIN

Take a group photo at this popular evening visit.

#### • PIAZZA BARBERINI

A large piazza in the city centre of Rome and situated on the Quirinal Hill.

#### • VIA DEL CORSO

A main street in the historical centre of Rome.

Guided tour of the oldest & biggest ice cream factory in Italy - includes a tasting!

# Trip highlights – Bay of Naples



## POMPEII

Buried by Vesuvius' 79AD eruption the preserved town has it all - houses, thermopolia, temples, baths, theatres, an amphitheatre, a palaestra and a forum. A chance to view everyday life in a prosperous town (at the height of the Roman Empire).



## HERCULANEUM

Better preserved than Pompeii, its smaller scale is more impactful, your pupils will gain an understanding of the topography of the town and how it was destroyed.



## VESUVIUS

After the short walk from the coach park to the rim of this magnificent active crater, your alpine guide will tell your group about the volcano's most famous eruption while your pupils admire the incredible view of the region.



## NAPLES ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

This fascinating museum contains wonderful exhibits including Roman mosaics wall paintings and Greek sculptures.



## SOLFATARA

Solfatara's tectonic activity makes it feel and smell much more like a volcano than Vesuvius. The Romans thought the entrance to the Underworld was located in this area and a visit will help pupils understand why.



## CAPRI

Pupils can take a guided tour of the island of Capri, including a visit to Ana Capri, a walking tour of the Gardens of Augustus and the Palace of Tiberus, a must for all classical fanatics. Groups can access the island by either ferry or hydrofoil.

#### • CUMAE

Cumae contains the long echoing cave of the Sibyl visited by Aeneas (even if only in legend).

#### • NAPLES UNDERGROUND TOUR & MUSEUM

Explore a series of ancient aqueducts 40m beneath Naples.

#### • OPLONTIS

With the supposed villa of the family of Poppaea, the second wife of Nero.

#### • POZZUOLI

Well preserved Flavian amphitheatre demonstrates the human aspect of the arena.

#### • PAESTUM

Site of three of the best-preserved Greek temples in the world.

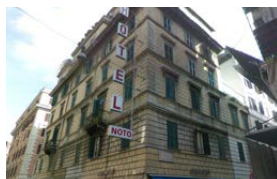

- Tipping is not expected other than in cafes, taverns, restaurants; although it's still not compulsory
- Groups need to apply for visit permits, we can assist with this process

# Trip highlights – Athens



## THE ACROPOLIS

See the Parthenon, the symbol of classical Greece, as well as the Erechtheum. Explore the Acropolis Archaeological Museum and take in the spectacular view from the Acropolis of the Theatre of Dionysos, the first stone theatre ever built.



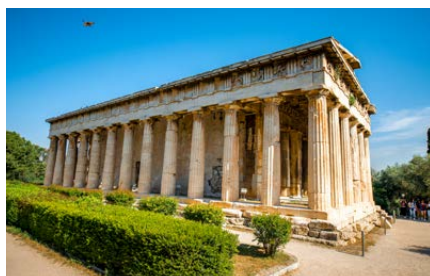
## GREEK TRAGEDY MASK

Two hour workshop presenting the ancient Tragedy Mask and its importance to the Greek Drama. The classical 'helmet' mask as depicted by archaeological evidence is considered by classicists as one of the defining conventions of Greek theatre.



## NATIONAL ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM

The most important archaeological museum in Greece has a vast range of exhibits. Use scenes from Greek vases to illuminate daily life or mythology or study the skills of the craftsmen of the Mycenaean world.



## THE AGORA

Take a close look at the Temple of Hephaestus, and visit the museum which provides evidence of politics and daily life in ancient Athens. A fascinating place for archaeologists to explore and walk in the footsteps of Socrates, Pericles and Cleon.



## AEGINA ISLAND

Take a cruise to the Island of Aegina where you can spend time visiting the Temple of Aphaea dedicated to the Greek Goddess. A separate full day cruise of the islands Aegina and Poros is also available.



## KERAMEIKOS CEMETERY & MUSEUM

Here among the ruins of the Sacred Way and the Sacred and Dipylon Gate, archaeology pupils will be in their element. In the museum, Classicists can marvel at the grave monument of Dexileos and a recently discovered early kouros.

Cape Sounion is a promontory located 69 kilometres south-southeast of Athens.

### • FORMER ROYAL PALACE

A representative sample of the early period of Neoclassicism in Greece and today, the seat of the Hellenic Parliament.

### • EVZONE GUARDS

See the changing of the guard at the Parliament.

### • PLAKA AREA

A maze of narrow, cobble-stoned, medieval streets that twist through ancient sites, tourist-packed squares and lovely Byzantine courtyards.

### • ACROPOLIS MUSEUM

Built to house every artefact found on the archaeological site of the Acropolis of Athens.

### • TRADITIONAL GREEK NIGHT

Enjoy an evening of Greek culture with some traditional folk dancing.

# Touring trip highlights



## DELPHI

Climb up the Sacred Way past the Treasuries and the Temple of Apollo to the stadium. The museum contains the 'Charioteer' and the sculpture of the Siphnian Treasury.



## OLYMPIA

Sculptures and artefacts help recreate the tumbled columns of the Temple of Zeus within the Altis (the Sanctuary of Zeus), a fascinating place to explore. Don't miss the Olympic Games Museum and Stadium site.



## MYCENAE

Mythology brought to life! Pass through the Lion Gate and climb to the palace in the footsteps of Agamemnon, the leader of the Greeks at Troy. Archaeology is made real here in the Treasury of Atreus and shaft graves.



## EPIDAURUS

A chance to see the best example of a Greek theatre (not transformed by the Romans), and test its perfect acoustics. The Sanctuary of Asklepios, a famous healing centre of the ancient world, is also worth exploring.



## TIRYNS WORLD HERITAGE SITE

In Mycenaean times Tiryns stood by the sea, commanding the coastal approaches to Argos and Mycenae. On a small scale and easy to understand it provides a great site for archaeology pupils to study a Mycenaean palace and Cyclopean walls.



## THE ANCIENT CORINTH

Explore the ruins of the once-great Roman city overlooked by the Greek temple of Apollo and the towering fortress of Acrocorinth. The well-preserved remains and the Archaeological Museum on the site helps pupils to visualise the city as it was.

### • TOLON

Visit the sites of the Argolid and then relax in this pleasant seaside resort.

### • MYSTRA

A great deserted, fortified Byzantine city overlooking the valley of the Eurotas.

### • SPARTA

Explore the city and visit the Tomb of Leonidas.

### • TRADITIONAL GREEK NIGHT, TOLON

Enjoy an evening of Greek culture with some traditional folk dancing.

### • OSIOS LOUKAS MONASTERY

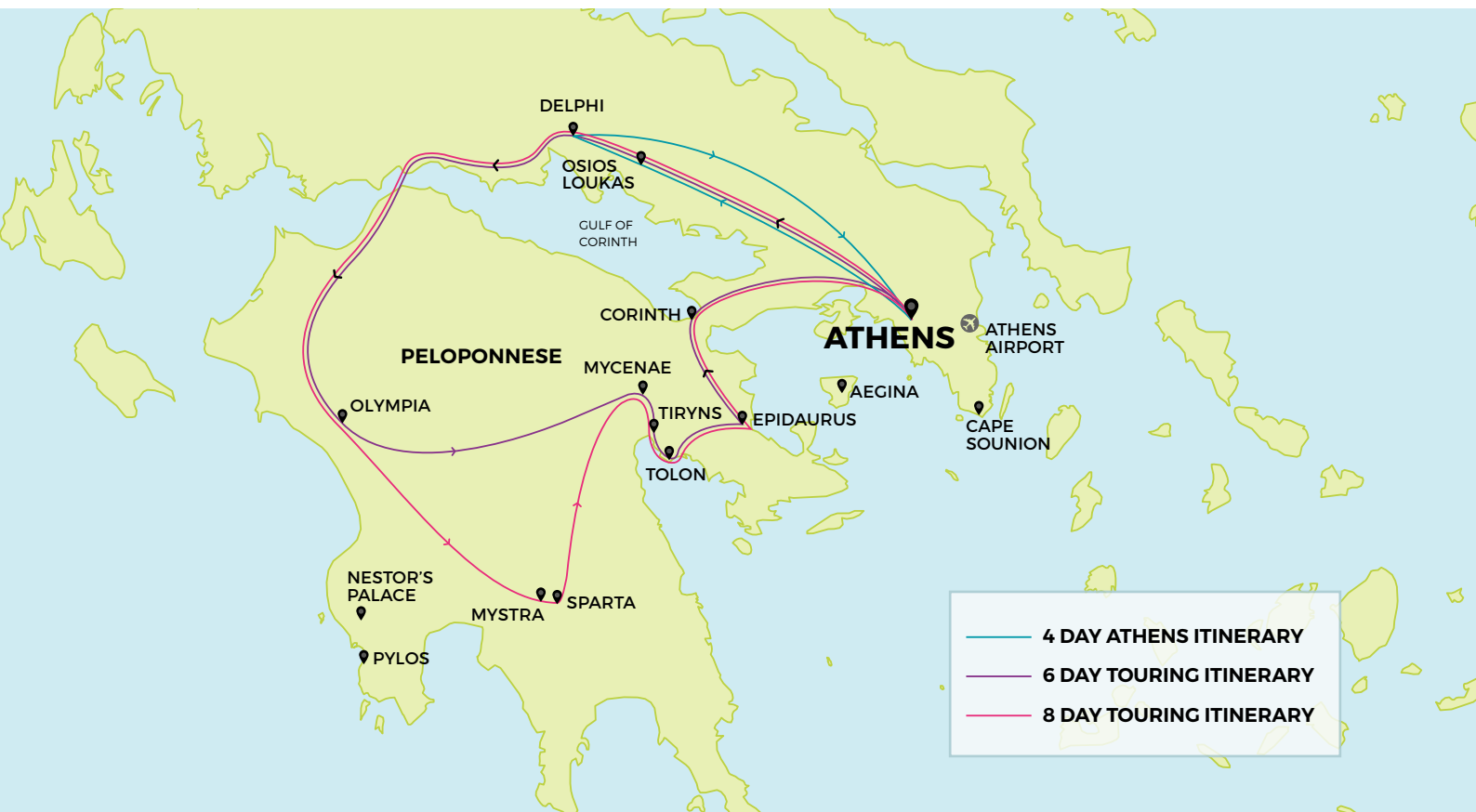

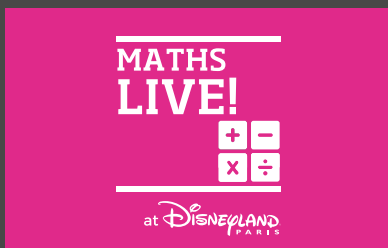

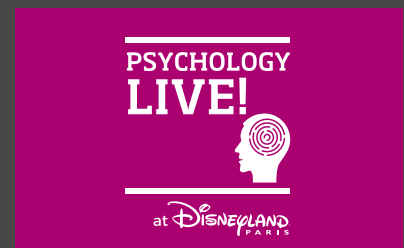
