## MUSIC THERAPIST

Use your music skills to help others. Communicate through music to help children and adults through a range of issues including eating disorders, anxiety, emotional issues and communication disorders. A truly rewarding career choice.

## PRIVATE MUSIC TEACHER

Good at music, teaching and business? This could be the ideal option for you. Private music teaching is often a part-time side-line career due to the after-school, evening and weekend working hours. You could teach children or adults as individuals or in group classes - in schools, at home or as part of a music service. A fun, rewarding option, and a skill that's always in demand.

## SOUND TECHNICIAN

An interesting career choice offering opportunities in a range of industries including advertising, broadcasting, film and theatre. You could choose to work in production (the initial recording of sound) or post-production (the editing of pre-recorded audio). This is a technical and challenging career choice ideally suited to candidates with a good ear and great technical knowledge.

## MUSICIAN

Create and/or perform music solo or as part of a group such as in a band, orchestra, or theatrical ensemble. Often self-employed, musicians work varied hours. You could choose to be a composer, instrumentalist and/or a singer performing either in the studio or before a live audience. Teach a subject you love and engage pupils aged 11-18 in developing their creative music skills. You'll plan and deliver lessons which reflect curriculum guidelines and cater for pupils with a range of musical interests and abilities. Inspire and challenge pupils to understand the intricacies of music, learn new instruments, and prepare them for qualifications.
