TET OFFENSIVE

This massive attack by the Vietcong showed that despite their military might, the US was failing to make real progress

LACK OF PUBLIC SUPPORT

Public figures such as
Muhammed Ali openly opposed
the draft. At Kent State
University, the National Guard
shot at anti-war protesters,
killing four and further souring
support

SEARCH AND DESTROY

These brutal tactics drove more civilians to support the Vietcong and led to the My Lai Massacre, killing 300 civilians and damaging the US's reputation

ROLLING THUNDER

This bombing campaign failed, as Vietcong used underground bases and tunnels to shelter from US bombs.

THE MEDIA

Shocking images broadcast at home caused many Americans to turn against the war
