#### Trees:

1 year-old saplings (40-60cm)

#### Hedges:

Double staggered hedge

- 10 inches between two rows
- Approx. 1 foot between each of the trees within a row

Triple staggered hedge (or more) is also possible.



#### Example hedge

Hedge = 150 feet

Double staggered hedge would require approx. 300 trees.

(150 trees, 1 foot apart, x2 rows)

#### Please note:

If you do not have room for 300 trees, you can donate a number of trees to one other local school.
